Criminal Record Check for VCS Volunteers

A Volunteer who needs a Criminal Record Check is anyone who is NOT PAID and helps in a classroom or anywhere in the school (ie hot lunches, One-to-One Reading, etc.) drives for a field trip, and has any one-on-one contact with students in our school.

We have signed up with the Ministry of Justice as a volunteer organization. The Criminal Record Checks (CRC) for volunteers are free of charge. If you fall into this description of a volunteer, you will need to have a CRC done every 5 years. If you currently have a CRC that is less than 5 years old, you can forward it to the school in person or by email.

If your CRC is expired or about to expire, please follow the steps below:

If you volunteer with us and do not have a CRC please follow these simple steps:

- 1. Go to this website: https://justice.gov.bc.ca/criminalrecordcheck
- 2. At the bottom of the page that comes up, there is a box for your

Vehicle Third-Party Liability - In order to drive for any school-related trips.

Once you have completed your Criminal Record Check and you plan on driving students to school-related activities in your vehicle, we require that you carry at least \$3 million in Third Party Liability on **EACH vehicle** that you drive.

We will need a copy of your vehicle insurance documents, showing this minimum amount or higher. This is shown on the 2nd page of your vehicle insurance papers (if coverage is through ICBC).

If you have more than 1 vehicle that you may use to transport students, we will need a copy of this paper for **EACH** of these vehicles.
